Born in Milan, Italy.

Full professor in computer science since 1994, he joined the “Università degli Studi di Milano” in 1998, where he served as Department Director and President of the Didactic Coordination Council.

His research activities refer to various aspects of computer architectures and information processing applications. In particular, he studied topics related to *microprocessor systems* (mainly system software for real time applications and hardware tools for performance monitoring), to *parallel and distributed systems* (parallel and distributed architectures, programming techniques for loosely coupled systems), to *dedicated architectures* (innovative architectures, mainly based on in-field programmable devices, for high-performance, high-reliability applications). Recently, he worked mainly on *distance learning strategies*.

He is (co)author of more than 100 papers, and he has been involved in various national and international research projects.

He has been President of CEPIS (the Council of European Professional Informatics Societies).
